Equipped with the latest in navigation technology, the Elsa Born Free features a Windlass Pro Series 1000, Lewmar Anchor, and a full suite of navigation lights to ensure safe passage day or night. The night searchlight and IC-M323G VHF Radio with Internal GPS provide added security and peace of mind. Additionally, a 1.5m aerial, AIS transponder, and advanced navigation system make this barge ready for any adventure.

Safety and comfort are further enhanced with a Nest Smart System Smoke Detector and Nest Smart Thermostat, maintaining optimal living conditions aboard. The boat is internet-ready with Cat 5 cable running from the Wheelhouse to the Lounge, and double-glazed windows with solid wood surrounds ensure excellent insulation and soundproofing.

Sustainability is at the heart of Elsa Born Free's design. The vessel is fitted with two 315w bifacial solar panels connected to a Victron 100/50 MPPT Controller and Victron Cerbo GX, providing efficient and reliable power management. This eco-friendly setup not only reduces the boat's carbon footprint but also ensures a steady supply of energy for all onboard systems.

The heart of the Elsa Born Free is its stunning galley, designed to be both stylish and functional. It boasts a Belling LPG cooker unit with an 8.8 KW output and a Thetford LPG hob unit with a 6KW output. The integrated 240v fridge and freezer, along with a large wine cooler, cater to all your culinary and entertaining needs. The solid oak kitchen units, complemented by quartz worktops, provide ample storage and prep space, while the large breakfast bar is perfect for casual dining or socialising.

The lounge area of the Elsa Born Free is a sanctuary of relaxation and entertainment. It features a Nabru corner unit sofa bed, a comfortable leather armchair, and a retro round wooden side table, creating an inviting space to unwind. The solid oak cabinet and Houdini hatch add to the room's charm. Entertainment is taken care of with a 55° Smart TV, Blaupunkt London120 radio, and speakers strategically placed in both the lounge and main bedroom. A Morso Squirrel multifuel stove with tile surround adds warmth and cosiness, making this the perfect spot to relax after a day on the water.
