With her solid wooden flooring throughout, spray foam insulation, and both pram and cratch covers, she's as practical as she is charming.

Powered by a robust 1.8 BMC engine, Lorien has been fitted with impressive energy solutions to support off-grid independence. Four 60mph lithium iron batteries with BMS are paired with four 400W solar panels, ensuring reliable, sustainable energy wherever the journey takes you. A 3kW inverter powers modern appliances with ease, while the 7kW multifuel stove keeps the boat toasty in all seasons. A 400L stainless steel water tank and 70L fuel tank further support extended cruising.

Inside, Lorien offers a warm and inviting interior with a spacious 6'1" cabin height. The layout begins with a tranquil master bedroom featuring a double bed, overhead storage, and reading lights—ideal for restful nights aboard. The bathroom follows, equipped with a full-size enclosed shower, a compost toilet with a 12V carbon filter and fan, and a stylish vanity unit, all designed to provide convenience without compromise.

The galley is a real highlight—open-plan, airy, and functional. Solid wooden countertops and sleek under-counter cupboards set the tone, complemented by a Hobsir induction hob, Morphy Richards electric oven, and a Logic washing machine. An integrated fridge and a charming breakfast bar with two stools overlook the swan hatch, making it a perfect spot for morning coffee or watching the water go by.

Toward the bow, the cosy saloon welcomes you with a pull-out sofa bed, a JVC Smart HD-ready TV, and an LG sound bar for evenings of entertainment. The large storage cupboard and multifuel stove add warmth and practicality, creating a relaxed and comfortable living space.
